This guide provides a color-coded 50-state overview and detailed explanation of the legality of hemp-derived cannabinoids (Delta-8 THC, Delta-9 THC, CBN, HHC) including cannabinoid limits (such as ratio or limits per serving or per container), product type restrictions (e.g food, dietary supplements, etc.) and age restrictions. ALABAMA	<p>Alabama does not have a THC standard for hemp products. However, hemp-derived "psychoactive cannabinoids" may be sold to individuals 21 years and older. "Psychoactive cannabinoids" means "cannabinoids derived from hemp," "including but not limited to," Delta-8 and Delta-10 THC. "Psychoactive cannabinoids" includes all hemp—derived cannabinoids, not just those that are generally understood to be impairing.</p> <p>(Act No. 2023-169 (S.B.66), 2023 Alabama Laws Act 2023-169) (Ala.
