

Hemp Product Licensing Guide

This chart identifies whether a state requires a license/permit/registration for retailers, wholesalers, and manufacturers of finished hemp-derived cannabinoid products and hemp ingredients. It also indicates whether there are requirements for labeling and packaging, finished product or ingredient testing, registration or endorsement for retail or specific products, age restrictions, and cannabinoid limitations. Unique state requirements are also included.
